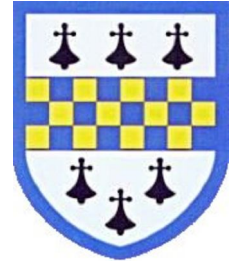

Dear Parent

You may be aware that an Ofsted Inspection took place in School on 13 & 14 May 2009. We have now received the report and I am attaching it to this letter.

We were absolutely delighted with the report and the comments made about the School by the inspection team. They repeatedly made reference to the good behaviour of the students, their desire to learn and do well and the quality of teaching in the classroom. They were extremely impressed with the achievements of our older pupils and the way they have caught up with their learning. We expect them to reach GCSE results in line with the top 25% of pupils in the country compared to their ability on entry to the school.

It has been a difficult few years with the School being placed in Special Measures and the challenge of moving into the new School, but I am sure you will agree that the new School, the pupils desire to do well and the commitment of their teachers to see them succeed has brought about a new beginning.

In nearly every category the School has been judged as "good". There are only four grades and we are next to the top.

It is the intention of myself, Tony Morrison (the new Principal) and all the staff that the next inspection will find us to be "outstanding".

It has been a wonderful experience to lead Park Hall and proved the highlight of my career in so many ways. I have felt privileged to work with such a great staff and such lovely children. You'll note we still have things to do and you can rest assured that Mr Morrison and myself will continue to strive to make Park Hall a School of which the Community can be proud.
