




Fig. 2 Flooding in part of rural Mozambique in 2009





Fig. 4 Coastal management plan for Surfers' Point in Ventura County, California




Fig. 5 Food shortages in part of Africa in 2011




Fig. 6 Plate boundaries in the 'Pacific Ring of Fire'






Fig. 7 OS map extract showing Cambridge Science Park





Fig. 8 Changes in the Human Development Index (HDI) for Nepal, South Asia and the World


