### Year Eleven Prom News

On Monday 20<sup>th</sup> January, we launched the details of the Year 11 Prom with the year group, explaining that it is a celebration of your child's time at Park Hall.

We are really pleased with how the majority of Year 11 students prepared themselves for the recent mock examinations and their ongoing commitment to their studies and all-important revision.

This year, the Year 11 prom will be held on **Friday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2025** at The Forest of Arden Hotel and Country Club. **The price of the ticket is £70.00.**

We request an initial deposit of £10.00 by Friday 28<sup>th</sup> February, followed by 3 payments of £20.00. Alternatively, it can be paid in full. These payments can be made online via Parentpay from Monday 27<sup>th</sup> January 2025. All payments need to be made by a final deadline of **Friday 30<sup>th</sup> May 2025.**

All students were notified of the attendance, punctuality, and behaviour expectations to ensure they are able to go to the prom in the Year 11 assembly. It was made very clear to students that should they receive significant numbers of negative behaviour points their prom place is at risk.

We would obviously like all students to attend this fantastic event and so should your child's place be at risk we will notify you separately and you will be given the opportunity to meet with your child's Head of Year to discuss strategies to support your child in improving attendance, punctuality and/or behaviour in order to secure their ticket.

Students at risk will also receive regular updates as to their performance. This early notification is to prevent parents and carers from spending money on prom arrangements should their son or daughter not be able to meet the required standards. However, these standards are our basic expectations of attending well, behaving well, and working hard in lessons and at home.

Finally, the Prom Committee will be shortly established and will be eager to meet to make key decisions. We will further communicate with you the finer details of this prestigious event in March.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all parent(s) and carer(s) for your ongoing support and ensuring your child is attending every day, on time and is working as hard as they possibly can in school and at home during this crucial year.
