Question - What lessons will I have at Park Hall?

Everyone will have the following lessons; English, Maths, Science, History, Geography, French, Citizenship, Technology, Art, Performing Arts (Dance, Drama, Music) and PE. As you move your way up the school, you might be able to study new subjects like Media, Sociology and Psychology.

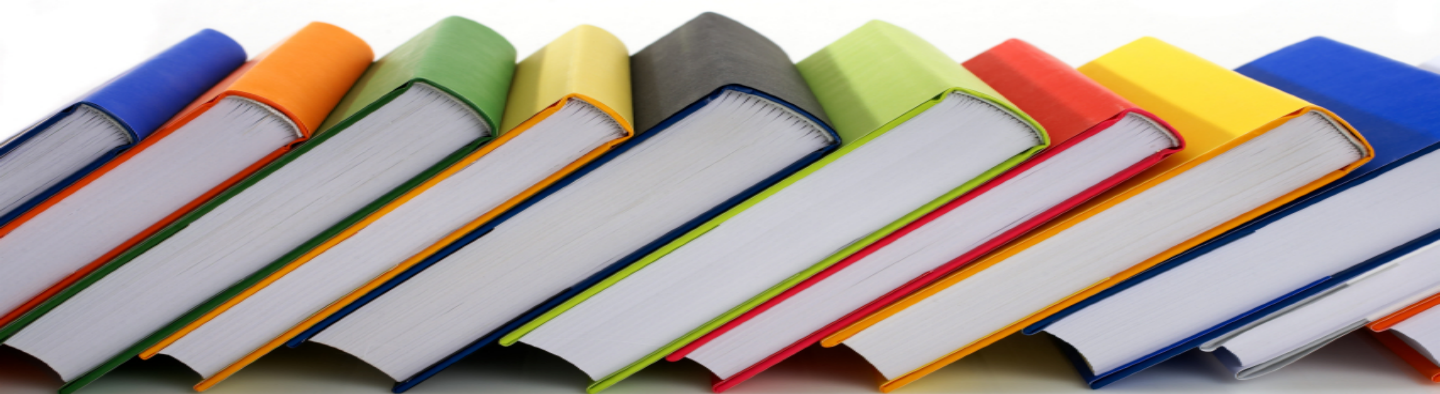
Question - How many lessons do you have a day?

Everyone has 5 lessons a day. There are two lessons before break, two lessons after break, and one after lunch. Every Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday you start by going to form and seeing your form tutor. On a Wednesday, you go straight to your first lesson.

Question- When will I know which lessons I have? When will I know who my teacher's are?

When you start school in September, you will be given a timetable. You can see an example of one on the other side of this page. You can see for each day what you have during each lesson. We call these 'Periods'. The name of your teacher is shown at the bottom. We have a 'two week timetable' which means one week it is week 1, then the next is week 2.
