When are exams being held for this subject?

Tuesday & Wednesday, 9th & 10th May

Speaking Exam Foundation Tier = 7–9 minutes + preparation time

Higher Tier 10–12 minutes + preparation time

This exam will be conducted with the students' class teacher and will include 3 sections comprising of describing a photo-card, a role-play and a general conversation section.

Tuesday 23rd May

Reading Exam (am) Foundation exam = 45 mins, Higher Exam = 1 hour.

Listening Exam (am) Foundation exam = 35 mins, Higher Exam = 45 mins.

Monday 5th June

Writing Exam (pm) Foundation exam = 1 hour, 5 mins, Higher Exam = 1 hour, 20 mins.
