Letter to parents regarding industrial action: Tuesday 2nd May

Dear Parent/ Carer

Following my previous letters last term and last week I am writing to remind you about our school arrangements for Tuesday 2nd May. It looks highly likely that the planned industrial action will continue to go ahead on this day. I would like to stress again that this strike action is in relation to a national dispute around teacher and school staff pay. We understand and appreciate the disruption this causes to learning and to families.

We plan to follow the same routine as we did last time. This is because we are striving to minimise disruption for those students who will be sitting external exams in the summer.

Yr11, Yr12 and Yr13: School will remain open to all students in Yr11, Yr12 and Yr13 as normal until 3.15pm. Students are expected to attend lessons in person as normal.

Yrs7-10: Lessons will be online using your usual school Microsoft Teams account from 9am until 3.15pm where possible. If your teacher does not start a live lesson you should complete the work that has been set on **Edulink** for your year group. Work on **Edulink** may not match your individual timetable. We apologise for any confusion regarding SENECA on Thursday.

School identified vulnerable students: We contacted you previously to discuss whether you would like your child to undertake silent, supervised study in school. The arrangements remain the same. Please let us know if there is any change.

Please note, as previously explained in earlier correspondence, we have moved back the published date of the Year 7 Parents Evening to Thursday 4th May. Year 7 parents/ carers should have already received details about this.

Why are we not opening to everyone?

Experience from the previous strike days has highlighted the approximate number of staff we can expect to be in attendance on both days. Student safety is of the utmost importance, and we must be sure we can keep our students safe on site with reduced staffing numbers.

Lastly, we want to take this opportunity to reiterate that your child's education is important to *all* staff at Park Hall Academy. We hope that by putting in place these contingency plans, including remote learning, we can limit any impact the industrial action could have to your child's education.

I'm sorry about the potential disruption to you, and to your child's education, especially for those parents/ carers who have had their normal working arrangements affected. We recognise that this comes during a period of other closures caused by bank holidays, including the forthcoming Coronation bank holiday. I understand that this situation may be frustrating, but ask that all members of our school community continue to treat each other with respect.
