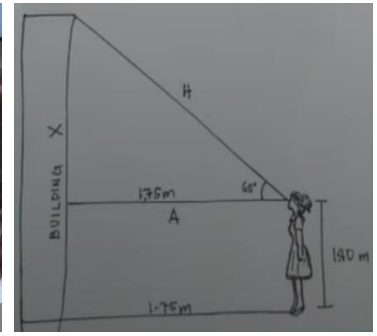
Y10 Careers Fair

Today, we welcomed a range of colleges and apprenticeship providers to speak to Year 10. As they are about to go on their Work Experience, students have had an opportunity to speak to specific colleges and apprenticeship providers about the courses they have on offer, and the different pathways they can do on Post 16.



Challenge of Calculating

This week, Mr Goodridge's Year 9 group enjoyed the challenge of calculating the height of various objects around the school. Students began the lesson by making a **clinometer** which they were able to use to calculate the angle of, for example, the top of the tree from a fixed point. Students then used **trundle wheels** to measure the distance between the fixed point and the bottom of the tree. Using **trigonometry**, students carried out the calculations needed to find the height of the tree including adding on the height of the student to ensure a more accurate measurement.
