Unit 8 Safeguarding in Early Years

<p>FIND A NEWSPAPER ARTICLE relating to safeguarding of children and summarise this in your own words.</p> <p>Stretch & Challenge: How far do you agree that a child's welfare is the early years professional's responsibility. Why might some people disagree?</p> 	<p>WRITE A TWEET OF AN OVERVIEW of the role of the early years professional in safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children</p> <p>STRETCH & CHALLENGE – TWEET OF AN OVERVIEW explaining your thoughts on how far adults keep children protected in the early years profession.</p> <p><i>Tweets must be no more than 140 characters and they must be informative.</i></p> 	<p>CREATE A FACEBOOK ACCOUNT that informs people of types of child abuse and child abuse indicators</p> <p><i>You should make it informative so that it could help someone.</i></p> 	<p>CREATE A FLOW CHART DIAGRAM that shows the process for reporting and recording concerns that a child is being abused.</p> <p>STRETCH & CHALLENGE – How might you train early years professionals to remember this process?</p> 
<p>CREATE A LEAFLET, which summarises how early year's professionals, must exercise their duty of care effectively, with reference to safeguarding children and promoting their welfare.</p> <p><i>Use key terms and images to make it informative and eye catching</i></p> 	<p>CREATE A FLOW DIAGRAM to explain a child-centred approach toward safeguarding children and promoting their welfare.</p> <p><i>Use pictures and keywords to explain the process in a clear way.</i></p> 	<p>WRITE A 10-15 QUESTION QUIZ on types of child abuse and their indicators with reference to early years settings.</p> <p><i>Write the questions and answers (on a separate sheet) to test a peer in class next lesson.</i></p> 	<p>CREATE A FACT SHEET, WHICH discusses, using examples of why it is important to follow procedures and policies in safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children in early years settings.</p> <p><i>Use a range of facts statistics and examples to support this.</i></p> 
<p>WRITE A NEWSPAPER ARTICLE with the title <i>'An analysis of the role of the early years professional in safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children of different ages.'</i></p> <p><i>Include specific, accurate information, with good English. You could include references to political philosophers, relevant quotes and statistical evidence. Have a look at a newspaper for some inspiration!</i></p> 	<p>Explain how safeguarding and promoting a child's welfare can link to another A Level topic other than English and Maths.</p> 	<p>Imagine you are teaching this part of the topic, YOU SHOULD COME UP WITH A STARTER OR PLENARY to discuss the impact of child abuse on a child's all-round development.</p> <p><i>Create a recap task, game or warm up for the class that could start a lesson off, or end it on.</i></p> 	<p>Design an attention grabbing WEBPAGE SUMMARISING the topic. You should discuss, using examples, why it is important to respond appropriately if a child talks about an issue that is of concern.</p> <p><i>Be creative, use any computer programme, and include factual information. You could include links to other websites too.</i></p> 
<p>DESIGN A LESSON USING THE 5 MINUTE LESSON PLAN (you can find this on the internet) to present reasoned conclusions about the ways in which early years professionals can most effectively contribute to promoting the welfare of children and safeguarding them from abuse to a Year 10 Child Development class.</p> 	<p>CREATE 2 SCENARIOS and analyse how early years professionals might approach children in the early years at different ages and stages of development when safeguarding them from abuse.</p> <p>How might their approach style differ?</p> <p>Make sure you include at least 2 different sources of information.</p> 	<p>CARRY OUT AN INSPECTION ON YOUR EARLY YEARS PLACEMENT. Evaluate how your early years placement setting identifies potential abuse and responds to any concerns.</p> <p>What improvements would you make and why?</p> <p>You may use questionnaires or observations</p> 	<p>READ 2 RECENT ARTICLES ON THE INTERNET on 'best practice when identifying and responding to any potential abuse'. Highlight key or major elements and compare this to your early years placement.</p>
